

#### European Fan

Surface texture is split, natural stone. Ideal with old world style architecture.



#### Seamless Slate

Surface texture is life-like, natural stone. Ideal with tropical, rustic, and modern architecture.



#### Cobblestone

Surface texture is natural slate. Ideal with old world style architecture.



#### Brick/Herringbone

Surface texture is new, unused brick. Ideal with traditional style architecture.



#### Random Stone

Surface texture is natural, fractured stone. Ideal with rustic or ranch style architecture.

## Stamped Concrete Color Options

Stamped concrete can be integrally colored when the concrete is poured, or it can be colored topically before the stamping process begins.



A lighter base color for the primary color of the concrete accented or highlighted by a darker secondary color is what makes stamped concrete come alive and provides the perception of stone, tile, wood, or rock.
